<p>Quotes/ important messages put forward</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provision of pure, safe and clean drinking water through tap connections, mechanisms to provide better storage drinking water facility and addressing repairs to already existing hand washing stations. • Strengthening of the school child cabinets, provision of soaps for hand wash. • Deputing teachers for MHM training to be imparted on hygiene module to be delivered to adolescent girls in schools. • Pressing the importance of the role played by the Teachers in implementation of the Operation & Maintenance module of the provided infrastructure in schools. • Focussing on delivering key Hygiene messages to school children (Hand washing, food / water handling practices, maintenance of personal hygiene etc) .

<p>Future plans/commitment</p>	<p>Through this orientation programme, the school Head Masters and teachers are being sought for their complete and wholehearted coordination, support, cooperation and commitment in providing pure, clean and safe drinking water to all the school children along with awareness generation on practising basic hygiene messages by school children and Menstrual Hygiene maintenance by adolescent girls.</p>
<p>Any other relevant information</p>	<p>It is also shared by participants that it is not only enough if any infrastructure is provided to school, they must also be made aware of the technicalities of the same (like Operation and Maintenance of the RO plants / filters installed in school for provision of safe and clean drinking water). Repairs to the defect bore wells is also a major concern and sought for immediate attention from the funders.</p>
