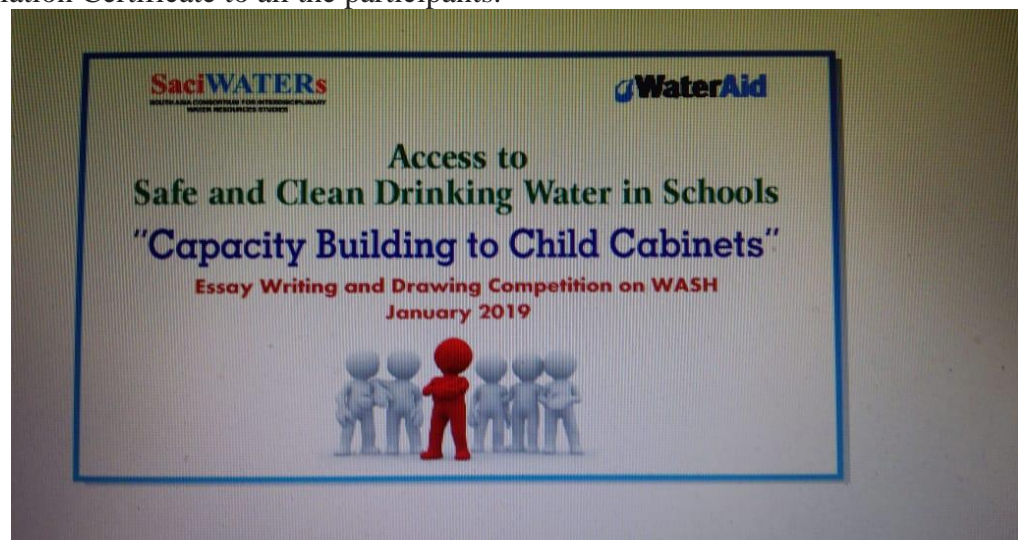

Students participated in the event very enthusiastically and have demonstrated their strong inclination towards the cultivation of responsible and caring BEHAVIOUR towards MOTHER NATURE and protection of natural resources in BEST possible way. At the end of the competition, two prizes under each category (Essay writing – 01st and 02nd prize, Drawing - 01st and 02nd prize) were announced along with presentation of Appreciation Certificate to all the participants.



The programme was conducted very well and students have received it with great enthusiasm and interest. Each participant was provided with a set of sketch pens, pencil, scale, chart paper along with two refreshments.
